



2023/2024 TOURNAMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

- OMHA rules will govern the tournament.
- The Tournament Convenor reserves the right to make any decisions regarding rules or regulations.
- Coldwater Minor Hockey will not be held responsible for any accident or injury that may occur during this tournament.
- Teams must be able and ready to play 15 minutes prior to scheduled game time and are to be out of the dressing room 20 minutes after the completion of their games.
- The third period will run straight time if there is a 5 or more goal difference. Stop time will apply again if the difference is for or less again. This will apply to all games including finals.
- Games will be 10-10-10 minute stop time periods
- No timeouts allowed



RULES & REGULATIONS

All games will be played until one team wins

Overtime will be "sudden death" using the following format...

1. 4 on 4 for a 2 minute shift
2. 3 on 3 for a 2 minute shift.
3. 2 on 2 for a 2 minute shift.
4. 1 on 1 for a 2 minute shift.

Each 2 minute shift will be a stop time\the player(s) that start a 2 minute shift must play the whole shift. No player changes can be made during that 2 minute shift either on the fly or during a stoppage of play. The only exception for a player change is when the play is stopped due to injury and the player must leave the ice. Coaches can assign any player they wish to the 2 minute shifts

Players receiving a penalty while 4 on 4 or 3 on 3 will be penalized for the full duration of the penalty. For example, a player receives a penalty during 4 on 4 the player will serve the remainder during 3 on 3 and 2 on 2 if necessary.

Players receiving a penalty during 2 on 2 will be penalized for the remainder of that 2 minute shift and the next shift will start 1 on 1.

Players receiving a penalty during 1 on 1 will result in automatic penalty shot for the opposing team.

A goalie must be on the ice for both teams at all times. During overtime- at no time during sudden death shifts may a goalie be pulled.
